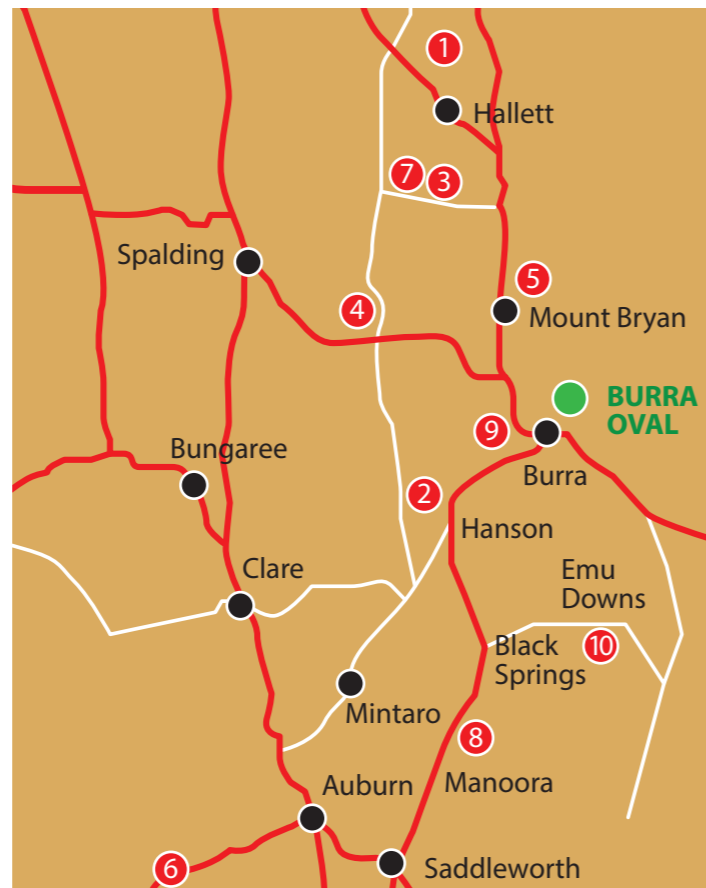

The 2025 Elders SA Stud Merino Expo will be the place to be in mid-March 2025; Merinos are truly a dual-purpose animal providing both meat for the protein market and also producing the natural fibre that is wool. The Expo is a great opportunity to view first class SA Merino genetics supplying these two markets.

We will begin the two-day expo on Wednesday, March 12 with multiple on-property displays. This is an interesting day, travelling around the mid and lower north of South Australia, viewing top quality genetics that have been run in this environment. See the young rams that are showing promise as well as top stud sires to be offered later in the year.

At the end of the day, everyone is welcome to join together for a special social evening at the Burra Oval, where AWI will host the Woolgrowers BBQ. This will again be accompanied by a fashion show organised by local fashion designer Emily Riggs from Iris and Wool. This will be the first showing of AWI's 2025 collection. This format change has proved a real success and greatly increased attendance from commercial producers keen to see the end product produced from their wool.

On Thursday, March 13 we return to the Burra Oval for the centralised display, comprising approx. 30 stud displays under marquees. This is a huge industry day and also attracts a variety of industry related displays.

There will be three judging events, the Universal Feeders SA Merino Championship Pair and the Elders Field Day Ram of the Year with the addition of a new class being a pen of three ram lambs. There will also be an award for "best exhibitor". All cash is generously supplied by Elders SA.

Our members would once again like to thank Elders for their long-standing commitment to this event, being the major sponsor for many years.

We look forward to seeing everyone back at Burra and the region in mid March 2025.
